## Nintendo DS Lite

The Nintendo DS Lite is a handheld gaming device. You purchase games for it on small media cards. It has the ability to communicate with other DS Lites nearby using a built-in application called PictoChat. It does not require batteries and is charged with a USB charger. It's available for around \$129. The games run from around \$10 to \$40.

1. To turn ON or OFF slide the Power button on the right side.
2. Touch the screen with external buttons with the included stylus to start (the other screen is not a touch screen).
3. If a game card is inserted, you will see the name of the game on the top of the touch screen. Tap it once to start the game.
4. To insert a game card, look on the spine of the device. To insert a game card, press the card until it clicks in. To remove a game card, press until it pops out.
5. To Play Big Brain Academy:
  - a. Insert the game card and follow onscreen instructions.
  - b. Click **Demo**.
  - c. Keep clicking the ▼ to get through the text on the top screen.
  - d. Choose a category and press **Start** onscreen.
  - e. To go back a screen click the arrow in the upper left.
  - f. To quit in the middle of a game, press the **Start** button (above **Select**).
6. To Play Guitar Hero:
  - a. Attach the Guitar Accessory (make sure it is firmly seated).
  - b. Insert the game card and follow the onscreen instructions (there are several startup screens).
  - c. When the main menu pops up, tap **Single Player**, then tap **Quickplay**.
  - d. Tap a song title to select it, then tap **Play**.
  - e. Choose your level of difficulty, then tap **Accept**.
  - f. To pause in the middle of a song, press the **Start** button (above **Select**).
