iPod nano

The iPod nano is a music and media player. You can listen to music and podcasts, and view music videos and movies on the device. All formats sync via iTunes (available for Mac or Windows). The iPod nano can also be used as a portable hard drive. A standard headset is required. It is charged with a USB charger. It's available starting at \$150 for the 8GB model (also available in 16GB size). The iPod must be formatted to work with either your Windows or Apple computer.

1. To turn ON press any part of the white wheel on the front of the iPod.
2. To choose from menus, use the scroll wheel to highlight item and select using the center button. To access different features, go to the main screen:
 - ▶ Music
 - ▶ Videos
 - ▶ Photos
 - ▶ Podcasts
 - ▶ Extras
 - ▶ Settings
 - ▶ Shuffle Songs
3. To return to a previous screen, press **Menu**.
4. To prevent your volume settings or song/video settings from accidentally changing while you're listening, use the **Hold** button in the left corner on the top of the iPod. Slide it to the right to turn it on, to the left to turn it off.
5. To adjust volume while a song is playing use scroll wheel to adjust volume up or down.
5. To turn OFF, press and hold the **Play/Pause** (>=) button
