## RCA Small Wonder

The RCA Small Wonder digital video recorder records up to 60 minutes of video depending on resolution and has an internal microphone. It requires 2 AA batteries to operate. It's available for around \$120.

1. To turn ON or OFF, press the power button located in the lower left of the control panel.
2. To record video:
  - a. Press **Red** button in the center
  - b. To stop recording, press **Red** button again
  - c. To zoom in while recording press the up or down navigation buttons
3. To playback:
  - a. To playback the last recording press **Play/Pause** button located in the upper right of the control panel
  - b. To stop during play press **Play/Pause** again.
  - c. To move through recordings use right and left navigation buttons
4. To change volume during playback, press the up (+) or down (-) arrows
5. To delete a recording press **Delete** and hold until **Video Deleted** message shows on screen.
6. To copy recordings to a computer:
  - a. Press and slide button up on the control panel's left to expose USB end.
  - b. Plug into USB port on your computer.
  - c. The Small Wonder has software on it that allows you to play and do simple video editing. You can also play the files (.avi) through Windows Media Player after you install the Small Wonder software from the camera.
  - d. You can edit, view, and share (via email or box.net) videos using the RCA Memory Manager software.
7. To view recordings on a TV, use a composite cable to plug directly into a TV
