Instructions: Use the copyright expiration charts to aid you in determining the copyright status of the following items. For each item, mark either “public domain,” “copyrighted,” or complete this sentence: “Next steps to determine copyright status are”

1. Published Baseball card from 1954. No copyright notice on the card.
2. Unpublished letter by June Appleby, dated 1922.
3. Unpublished photograph of local water tower, donated by Mr. Jebediah Smith around 1940.
4. Published sheet music by Irving Berlin, *A Pretty Girl is Like a Melody*, 1919
5. Film by local chamber of commerce, 1927. The film has no underlying copyrighted works to consider (e.g. music, poetry). It is interviews with local residents and business people.
