This program will enable public libraries that meet the Microsoft giving guidelines to have access to the most current applications available for public access computing.

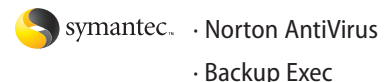
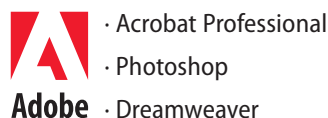

How can my library request products through TechSoup Stock?

1. Create a MyTechSoup personal account:
Go to www.techsoup.org/stock, click **Join MyTechSoup** under **Manage My Account** in the upper-left column, and follow the directions.
2. Create an organization account for your library:
Log in to your personal MyTechSoup account, and click **Register My Organization** under **Manage My Account** and follow the directions. (If you see that your organization is already listed at this point, it means that your organization is already registered. Check www.techsoup.org/stock/gettingstarted.asp for instructions in this case).
3. **If your library has 501(c)(3) nonprofit status**, you'll be directed to send us federal documentation of your nonprofit status, so that we can determine your organization's eligibility. **If your library is not a 501(c)(3) library, no documentation is necessary.**
4. Visit www.techsoup.org/stock/libraries for more information about our library programs and to find products your library is eligible for.
5. Order product donations that are appropriate for your organization (you must be logged in to your MyTechSoup account to order), by adding products to your cart and checking out.

NOTE: Each individual library branch requesting products from TechSoup Stock must be registered at TechSoup Stock.
