



To start the Secondary Logon service

1. Open Services
2. In the **Name** column, click **Secondary Logon**.
3. On the **Action** menu, click **Start**.

Note

- To open Services, click **Start**, click **Control Panel**, click **Performance and Maintenance**, click **Administrative Tools**, and then double-click **Services**.
- The Secondary Logon service allows you to run programs (*.exe), saved Microsoft Management Console (MMC) consoles (*.msc), shortcuts to programs and saved MMC consoles, and Control Panel items as an administrator, even while you are logged on to your computer as a member of another group, such as the Users group or the Power Users group.
- By default, the Secondary Logon service starts automatically when the system starts. For more information about how to configure startup options for services, see Related Topics.
- The **runas** command allows a user to run specific tools and programs with different permissions than the user's current logon provides. For more information about this command, see Related Topics.
