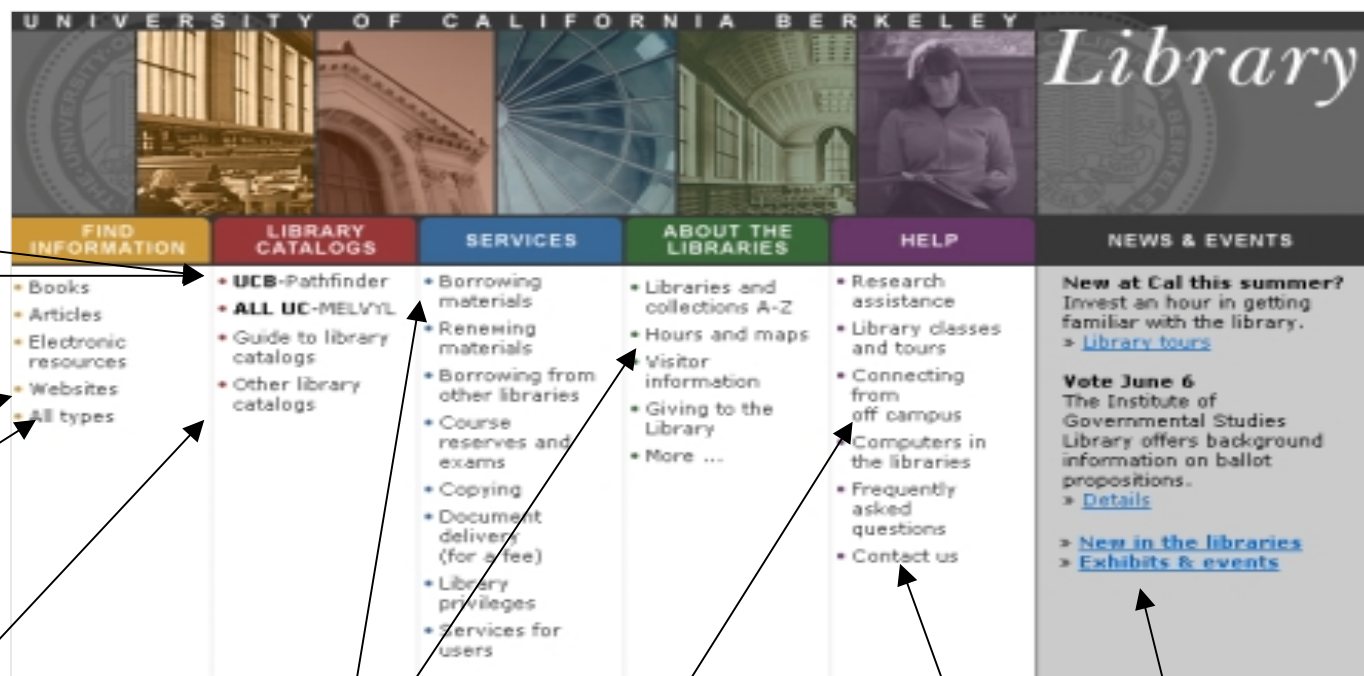


Handout #6 Two Different Handout Models
