

Exercise #2

Starting to Use CSS

1. Open Notepad. There is a file on your desktop call cssclass.css. Open the file in Notepad. Put a comment in it. Perhaps something like:

```
/* File name: cssclass.css  
Purpose: This file was created to learn CSS. */
```

Now save the file **using Ctrl+S**. This will be the file you use for the rest of the class to format your HTML content page.

2. With Notepad still open, start a new session of Notepad.
 - 1) There is an HTML file on your desktop called cssclass.html.
 - 2) Open this file in Notepad.
 - 3) Open Internet Explorer, then open cssclass.html in Internet Explorer. Keep IE open for future viewing.

3. In Notepad, open cssclass.css.
 - 1) Add some of the selectors, properties, and values we have covered in class.
 - 2) Save the file **using Ctrl+S**.
 - 3) Refresh HTML file cssclass.html in Internet Explorer and see how it looks using the stylesheet cssclass.css.
 - 4) Make other changes see how it looks again.
