

## Nintendo Wii

The Wii is a game console that connects to your TV. Games are played using a remote. Some games require additional accessories. The console doesn't require batteries. The remotes use 2 AA batteries. The Wii console is available for around \$500.

### To Play Big Brain Academy

1. To start Big Brain Academy
  - a. Put in the Big Brain Academy disk
  - b. Press the A button on top of remote to continue
  - c. *Please put the remote strap on your wrist and tighten it*
  - d. Point remote to Big Brain Academy in upper left corner and press A
  - e. Point to Start with Remote and press A
  
2. To play Big Brain Academy
  - a. Use remote to choose **solo**
  - b. Choose **practice**
  - c. Choose player and press **ok**
  - d. Choose a category to practice:  
(**visualize, identify, memorize, compute, analyze**)
  - e. Choose an activity and difficulty level (I suggest starting with **Easy**)

### To Play Wii Sports

1. To start Wii Sports
  - a. Put in the Wii Sports disk
  - b. Press the A button on top of remote to continue
  - c. *Please put the remote strap on your wrist and tighten it*
  - d. Point remote to Wii Sports in upper left corner and press A
  - e. Point to Start with Remote and press A
  
2. To play Wii Sports, choose a sport and follow onscreen instructions
  - If you choose to Box, you need to attach a nunchuck to each remote.
  - To play with two players, you need to activate the second remote. The main remote will be used to make choices until you get into a game when both remotes will work.
  
3. To practice a sport use Training mode
