
Ideas how to end your story:

LESSONS LEARNED - Tell us what you learned from this personal journey

ANSWER - If you asked a question, go ahead and answer it now

WRAP AROUND - Refer back to what you told us at the beginning it will help us feel like we went full circle with you



Things to possibly start your story with:

HOOK - Something that say's listen to me, I've got something you'll want to hear

QUESTION - Ask a question that your story will help answer


BACKGROUND - Tell us anything that is important to know that will help us to understand your story better

When you build your story things to review to make it stronger:

FOCUS - Write down 2 or 3 main points to help keep your story on target

EMOTIONAL CONTENT - Don't recite a "laundry list" of facts and data, we want to know what you feel (try using statements that involve your senses - See, Touch, Smell, Hear and Taste) & add statements that will make us laugh and cry with you

AUDIENCE - Pick someone or a some group to tell your story too & don't change who you are talking to mid-story



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
