

Tips for the Approach

- Research Location
- Write Script in Bullet Points
- 1st Call or In-Person, Last Email
- Always talk to the General Manager
- WIFT- What's in it for them?
- Always ask for their contact information

The Approach - Pottery Barn for Kids

WIFT

- Appeal to parents during sale/clearance season
- Captive audience of parents and kids for 30 minutes in your store
- Average attendance of 20-30 parents and kids

- Venues were only in the City of Palo Alto






