Plan Bilingual Storytime

In this exercise you will plan the first bilingual storytime you will do upon return to your workplace.

5. How can grown-ups participate in finger-plays? Will you have handouts for them?

6. Are there any regular traditions you can establish?

7. Will there be a craft or other activity?

8. Plan the sequence of reading books and other activities.
