

## Exercise #2

### Using Search Engines

In this exercise you will practice creating a lesson plan for teaching Spanish-Speaking patrons how to use search engines.

1. In this exercise you will work in pairs.
2. Take about 25 minutes to develop a five-minute lesson *in Spanish* that includes:
  - a. A description of the lesson and the learning objectives
  - b. The steps to set up **Google** in Spanish and a description of how to perform a search using **Google**. Include **two or three** examples of searches that you would use to show your patrons how to use search engines.
  - c. A description of a practice exercise on how to perform a search using **Google**
