






WE ARE DIFFERENT, WE ARE THE SAME: HELPING CHILDREN LEARN ABOUT DIVERSITY

"FILL THEIR LIVES WITH AS MANY POSITIVE EXPERIENCES WITH DIVERSITY AS POSSIBLE"





WHEN DO CHILDREN NOTICE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN PEOPLE?

- At age 2, children begin to notice gender & racial differences.
- At 2 ½ or so, children learn gender labels
 (boy/girl) which they begin to apply to skin color.
- Around 3 years of age, children notice physical disabilities.
- At about 4-5 years, they start to display genderappropriate behavior and become fearful of differences.

LEARNING ABOUT DIFFERENT CULTURAL ASPECTS OFFER NEW EXPERIENCES FOR CHILDREN. IT ALSO HELPS THEM REALIZE THAT WE'RE ALL HUMANS, DESPITE DIFFERENCES IN HOW WE LOOK OR DRESS, OR WHAT WE EAT OR CELEBRATE.

All types of differences such as race, religion, language, traditions, and gender identities can be introduced through crafts and activities.





