Goldilocks and the Three What? Story and Craft Agenda

Description: A UPS librarian will come to your library to tell the original story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Then s/he will read Goldilocks and the Three Dinosaurs by Mo Willems, leading the children in a short age appropriate discussion about the differences in the stories. Children will have the opportunity to make their own story artwork, based on their imagination and probably involving bears and maybe even dinosaurs!

Cost/Supplies: Please have crayons and glue sticks on hand.

Prep Time/Duties: Very little prep time. Flyers, and word of mouth promotion.

Attendance limits: Limited to the community room or storytime area size.

Public Blurb: Enjoy stories about Goldilocks and the Three Bears or maybe Dinosaurs!! Children will be making a craft based on the story of Goldilocks, but limited only to their imagination. All supplies are provided. Children 3 and up.

You will need:

- 1. Books (in the box)
- 2. Master copies of the three bears and Goldilocks
- 3. Plenty of print outs of artwork
- 4. Popsicle sticks and/or tongue depressors
- 5. Glue sticks (branch should provide)
- 6. Scissors (branch should provide)
- 7. Crayons (branch should provide)

How to do it:

- 1. Plan to read one or two books prior to the craft. It is easier to keep the kids separated from the craft items at first. Harder to reel them in after stories. ;O)
- 2. Have packets of supplies divided up for ease of distribution
- 3. Have containers of crayons ready to go on each table
- 4. Have glue sticks and scissors divided up too. If you precut the artwork it will be a shorter craft, but then there will be time to act out the "play"
- 5. Have a "stage" area so that the kids can take turns putting on a "show".
