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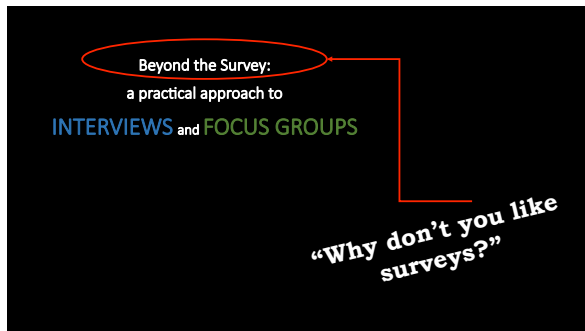
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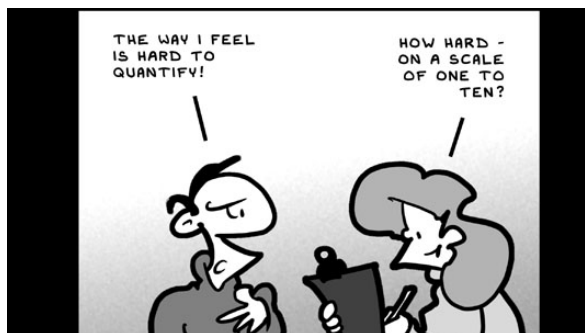

3. What additional support would help you?

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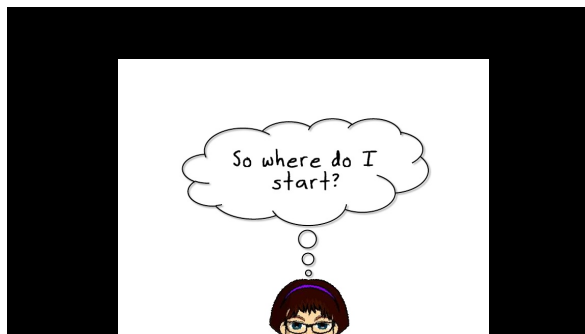
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Follow these steps for success:

- 4) Package and Deliver



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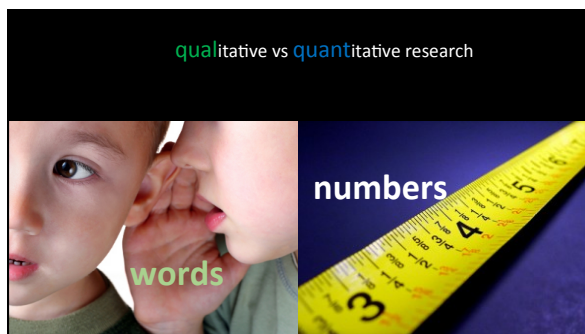
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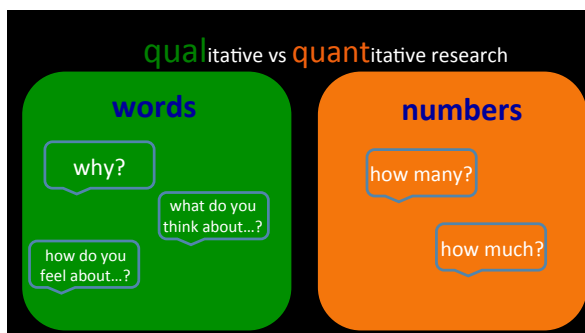
